

## Contractor to Contractor Agreement

### ARTICLE 1. SCOPE OF THE WORK

The Contractor shall furnish site walk after the 3 day recession, labor, electrical materials, permitting and perform all of the work shown on the drawings as per Owners requests. Contractor will also chose the right areas for the arrays to be placed to maximize the rebate. Contractor shall pay up to \$250.00 for any fees in permit processing. Owner will reimburse for extra expense of fees.

### ARTICLE 2. TIME OF COMPLETION

Owner will furnish all modules, inverters and DC disconnects for any and all jobs to be complete. Any purchases by the Contractor for any needed material in connection with any project will be billed to the Owner in itemized statements.

### ARTICLE 3. THE CONTRACT PRICE

The Owner shall pay the Contractor for the labor to be performed under the Contract the sum of 1.75 per watt on comp shingle roof, additional cost based on difficulty of roof material and tilt. Any and all Ground Mount system would be charged out at \$2.75 per Watt due to additional equipment & materials need for such job. Owner will approve all jobs before contractor starts. Trenching is extra and need to see on site.

### ARTICLE 4. PROGRESS PAYMENTS

Payments of the Contract price shall be paid in the manner following:

20% on approval of prints 2 to 7 depending on job size.

40% on permit approval 1 day to 6 weeks depending on permit department.

40% on city permit sign-off 1 to 2 days after completed install.

### ARTICLE 5. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. All work shall be completed in a workmanship like manner and in compliance with all building codes and other applicable laws.
2. To the extent required by law all work shall be performed by individuals duly licensed and authorized by law to perform said work.
3. Contractor shall furnish Owner appropriate releases or waivers of lien for all work performed or materials provided at the time the next periodic payment shall be due.
4. All change orders shall be in writing and signed by both Owner and Contractor.
5. Contractor warrants it is adequately insured for injury to its employees and others incurring loss or injury as a result of the acts of Contractor or its employees.
6. Contractor shall obtain all permits necessary for the work to be performed.
